

# Exploring The Pacific Islands

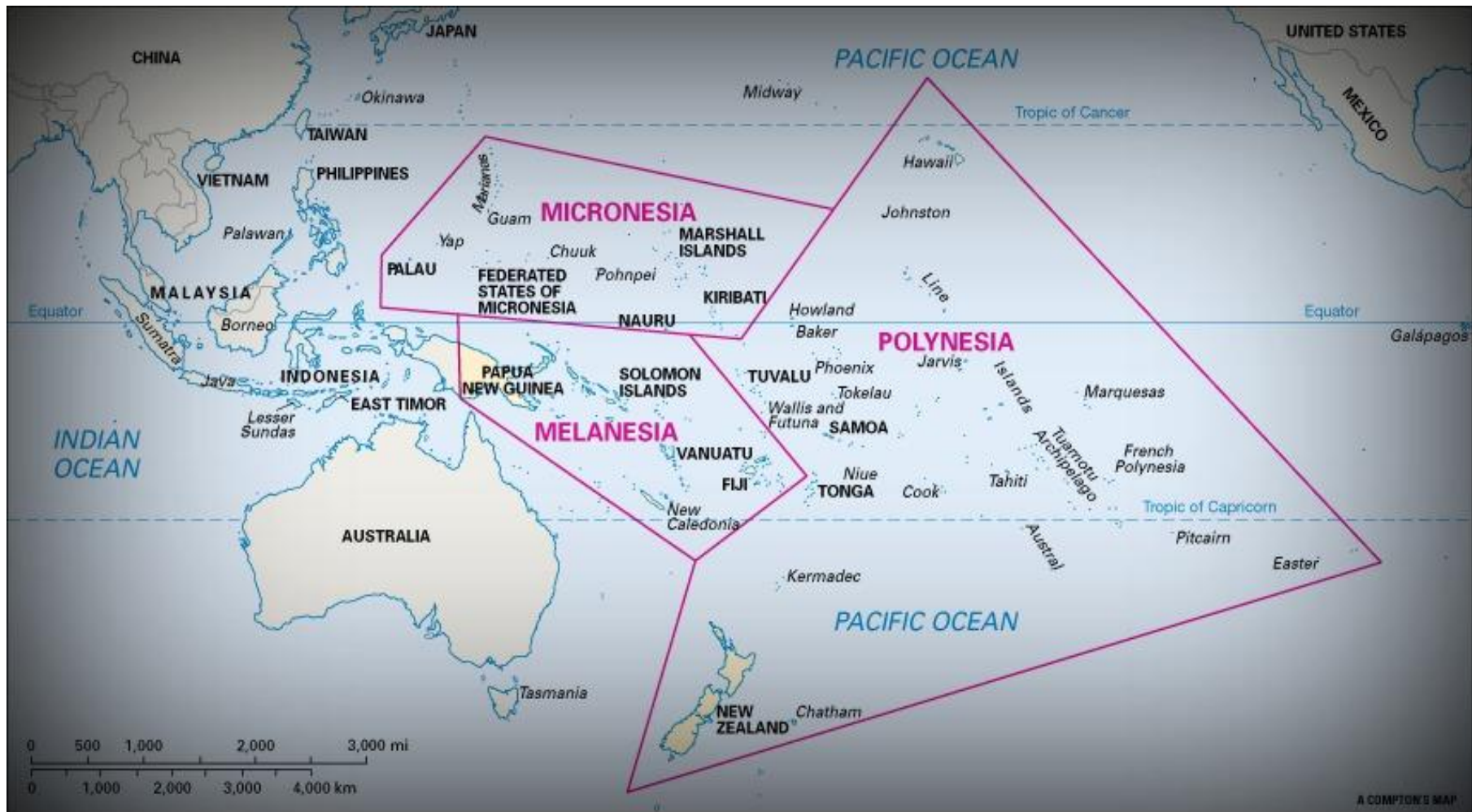
In this printable file you will find a map of the Pacific Islands, including Melanesia, Micronesia, and Polynesia. I have also included a very brief description for each region.
